It consists of a total number of 30 digits, based on 17 codes included in 16 variables and organised into 13 decision clusters, yielding 6 diagnoses.

It is based on Overall, Hollister, Johnson and Pennington's paper entitled "Nosology of depression and differential response to drugs," published in the *Journal of the American Medical Association* in 1966, in which, three empirically derived depressive types were

identified by factor analysis of Overall and Gorham's Brief Psychiatric Rating Scale (first presented in *Psychological Reports* in 1962): anxious depression, hostile depression, and retarded depression. In revised CODE-DD there is also a mixed form of depression. Anxious depression is characterised by depressed mood with anxiety and hypochondriasis (tension, or vegetative manifestations); hostile depression by depressed mood with hostility and suspiciousness; and retarded depression by depressed mood with apathetic indifference (constricted affect, or lack of interest) and motor retardation (stupor).
