9. MANIA/ HYPOMANIA

Present, stop Absent, stop PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER MASKED DEPRESSION

It consists of a total number of 12 digits, based on 12 codes included in 9 variables organized into 3 decision clusters, yielding 1 diagnosis.

It is based on W. Walcher's monograph *Die larvierten Depression*, published in 1969, in which masked depression is defined. In revised CODE-DD it is characterized by hypochondriasis (somatic symptoms, or vegetative manifestations) with insomnia, decreased appetite (weight loss), anxiety, bodily misperceptions, aches and pains, lack of drive and worse in the morning.
