It is based in Michael Liebowitz, Frederic M. Quitkin, Jonathan Stewart, Patrick Mc Grath, Wilma Harrison and Judith Rabkin's paper entitled "Methodological issues in developing nosological systems for chronic depressive illness," published in the *Psychopharmacology Bulletin* in 1984 in which Atypical depression was described as depression associated mood

reactivity and two or more of the following: increased appetite or weight gain, oversleeping or staying more time in bed or severe fatigue creating a leaden paralysis.

In revised CODE-DD it is characterized by depressed mood, associated with reactive mood changes, hypersomnia, excessive appetite, lethargy or asthenia
