It consists of a total number of 53 digits, based on 21 codes included in 19 variables organized into 19 decision clusters, yielding to 7 diagnoses.

It is based on Cullen's *Synopsis Nosologiae Methodicae* published in 1769 in which melancholia, a disorder of judgement (vesania) in the class of neuroses (injuries of sense and motion) is defined as partial madness without dyspepsia, separated from hypochondriasis, a disease with dyspepsia, and divided into eight forms from which only five are included in revised CODE-DD: melancholia with weariness of life, melancholia with fear of future, melancholia with aversion from motion, melancholia with restlessness and impatience, and melancholia with concerns of body and affairs.

Included also are hypochondriasis for patients who don't qualify for the diagnosis of melancholia because of dyspepsia, pure melancholia for patients who qualify for the diagnosis of melancholia but don't qualify for any of the forms of melancholia, and mixed melancholia for patients who qualify for more than one form of melancholia. Hypochondriasis in revised CODE-DD is characterized by dyspepsia with hypochondriasis; melancholia by the absence of dyspepsia with depressed mood; melancholia with weariness of life by depressed mood with loss of desire to live (suicidal tendencies); melancholia with fear of future by depressed mood with feeling of hopelessness (pessimistic outlook); melancholia with aversion from motion by depressed mood with motor retardation (withdrawal, or stupor); melancholia with restlessness and impatience by depressed mood with agitation (motor restlessness); and melancholia with concern of body and affairs by depressed mood with hypochondriasis or feeling of impoverishment.
