## KARL FRIEDRICH FLEMMING'S CRITERIA OF DYSTHYMIA ATRA

## 1. DEPRESSED MOOD

Present, proceed to 2 Possible Dysthymia Atra
Absent, stop PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER

- 2. ANXIETY
- 3. IRRITABILITY
- 4. SUSPICIOUSNESS

All 3 present, proceed to 5 Probable Dysthymia Atra
Less than 3 present, stop PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER

5. MANIA/ HYPOMANIA

Present, stop PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER
Absent, stop DYSTHYMIA ATRA

It consists of a total number of 6 digits, based on 6 codes included in 5 variables organized into 3 decision clusters, yielding 1 diagnosis.

It is based on Karl Friedrich Flemming's paper, *Allgemeine Zeitschrift fur Psychiatrie*, published in 1844, in which dysthymia atra was described as depression of mood associated with fear and anxiety, irritability and mistrust. In revised CODE-DD it is characterized by depressed mood, associated with anxiety, irritability and suspiciousness.
