First	Anxiety disorders are “effects of illness”	No productive psychopathologic symptoms; pattern of behavior is congruent with content of abnormal forms of experience
Second	Separation of Panic Disorder from Generalized Anxiety Disorders	Nil

Fourth	Separation of phobic disorders from obsessive compulsive disorders	Nil
Fifth	Nil	Partial, abortive and incomplete
